I am an experienced childcare professional with over a decade working as a male nanny, governor and boarding houseparent. I place emphasis on creating positive routines and good habits to help children feel safe and supported. I hold high expectations for the children in my care, using my passion for sports and my background in education to build a strong rapport and keep consistent boundaries. I am looking for a long-term commitment from September 2026. I'd like to move away from my self-employed work and settle down in an employed position for one family.

I have been working as a proxy parent, male nanny and governor for ten years since my first role in September 2016. I provide childcare, tutoring, and pastoral/behavioural support for private families internationally. I have worked in over 25 different countries including England, Australia, US, Qatar and France. I support families in creating strong routines and good habits tailored to their children's academic, social, and emotional development. (June 2022 – Present) Group Leader - Camp Pontiac - New York, USA

I've worked at an exclusive seven-week overnight summer camp in the US for the last five summers. In my role as a group leader, I am responsible for a division of up to 20 camp counsellors and 60 children who live at camp for seven weeks. My role includes supporting children with homesickness, handling challenging behavior and managing the counsellors. I am also the point of contact for the children's parents throughout the seven weeks.

(September 2024 – December 2025) Assistant Head of Boarding - Windlesham House School Sussex, England

I started this term-time position to work alongside my male nanny/governor work during school holidays. I left at the end of the winter term due to declining boarding numbers and a preference to working in private households. At Windlesham House School, I led the junior boys' boarding provision for pupils in Years 3 to 6 and took responsibility for organising and overseeing the weekend programme. I helped build a structured and engaging boarding experience for pupils. I also transformed the weekend provision, where I oversaw all aspects of school life from managing staffing, creating a varied weekend programme and organising trips.

(September 2020 – April 2021) Assistant Houseparent – The Yehudi Menuhin School Surrey, England

I was an Assistant Houseparent at a renowned music school in Surrey. I was responsible for the pastoral care and welfare of 33 boys aged between 9 and 18 who live in the boarding house during term-time. The position included leading the morning and evening routines as well as offering support during the school day.
