I am an experienced childcare and education professional with over a decade working as a tutor, male nanny and governor. I place a strong emphasis on creating strong routines and good habits where children feel safe and supported. I hold high expectations for the children in my care through a strong rapport and consistent boundaries. I use my passion for sports and my background in education to support children's physical, emotional and academic development.

Work History

(April 2020 – Present) Self-Employed Male Nanny/PA – www.liambaxter.co.uk

In April 2020, I launched my website to advertise the work I do as a proxy parent, male nanny and tutor. I have been working as a male nanny since my first role in September 2016. I provide childcare, tutoring, and pastoral/behavioural support for private families internationally. I support families in creating strong routines and good habits tailored to their children's academic, social, and emotional development. (June 2022 – Present) Group Leader - Camp Pontiac - New York, USA

I've worked at an exclusive seven-week overnight summer camp in the US for the last five summers. In my role as a group leader, I am responsible for a division of up to 20 camp counsellors and 60 children who live at camp for seven weeks. My role includes supporting children with homesickness, handling challenging behavior and managing the counsellors. I am also the point of contact for the children's parents throughout the seven weeks.

(September 2024 – December 2025) Assistant Head of Boarding - Windlesham House School

At Windlesham House School, I led the junior boys' boarding provision for pupils in Years 3 to 6 and took responsibility for organising and overseeing the weekend programme. I helped build a structured and engaging boarding experience for pupils. I also transformed the weekend provision, where I oversaw all aspects of school life from managing staffing, creating a varied weekend programme and organising trips.

(September 2020 – April 2021) Assistant Houseparent – The Yehudi Menuhin School – Surrey

I was an Assistant Houseparent at a renowned music school in Surrey. I was responsible for the pastoral care and welfare of 33 boys aged between 9 and 18 who live in the boarding house during term-time.

(October 2019 – April 2020) Live-In Nanny [High-Profile Family] – Virginia Water, Surrey

I looked after four boys aged five, seven, twelve, and fourteen years old. The position included providing fun activities for the children to do on weekends, cooking breakfast for the children, and driving to different activities. I worked as part of a team in a fully staffed household.

(November 2018 – May 2019) Temporary Live-In Nanny – Woking, Surrey

I cared for two boys aged 7 and 8 in Woking while their mum recovered from surgery. I managed the children's daily routines, including meals, homework, and after-school activities. Originally a short-term role, my contract was extended until May.

(May 2018 – June 2018) Holiday Nanny – Bali, Indonesia

I looked after two boys aged 9 and 14, keeping them engaged with activities like water parks, surfing, ATV riding, and escape rooms. I tailored activities to suit their ages, ensuring they stayed active and involved.

This temporary nanny position was over the summer holidays looking after two boys aged 8 and 10.
